We talked about why God made the universe so big, and why He made us in His own image. From the flaming sword of Eden and the pillar of fire in the desert to the apocalyptic moon and falling stars of Revelation, God has confronted us with images that pierce the darkness and speak beyond the physical world we know or the earthly life we understand.

I pray that the light of the Gospel, the true light that shines in the darkness, will be the center of your life and the life of every student at Immanuel Christian School. May that same light which illuminated our world and changed history forever; move us to know Him more fully and more deeply and to discover our place in God's great universe.
